

Student Ministries and Activity Center Gaming Use Guidelines

Wow, how exciting it is to be able to share the resources that God has entrusted to our care. It is the hope of Student Ministries that the gaming systems will be an asset for your ministry/group. Please read over the gaming station policy on the next panel, then make your game selections, complete the back panel and return to the Student Ministries office or Central Supply Box 31. Thanks again for your careful attention to the gaming station policy and your partnership with Wooster Grace for the furtherance of Christ's Kingdom.

Guidelines

The overriding goal of these guidelines is to care for the equipment and keep it in good working order for many years to come. Having said that, please review these guidelines carefully:

- A fee of \$10 per station is for upkeep and maintenance.
- The gaming systems and cabinets may not be moved from their original location.
- All ministries/groups must complete and return the included request form to the Student Ministries office prior to use of the gaming stations, equipment, accessories, etc. The Student Ministries Team must approve the request before the keys to the system cabinets will be released.
- Keys should be returned to the Student Ministries office or Central Supply Box 31 after use.
- When playing on the Wii stations, every player MUST use the wrist strap and each remote must have the protective gel cover on.
- Each station being used by students or children must have at least one adult leader supervising the use of the equipment.
- Lock gaming station cabinets when you're through. Make sure both cabinet doors are locked. Everything should be returned to the place it was found.
- The ministry/group using the gaming stations agrees to pay for the cost of replacements of all systems, equipment, accessories, and games that are broken, damaged or stolen during the time your ministry/group are in possession of the gaming keys. Please inspect the equipment you are using at the beginning of your event to avoid being held accountable for the equipment.
